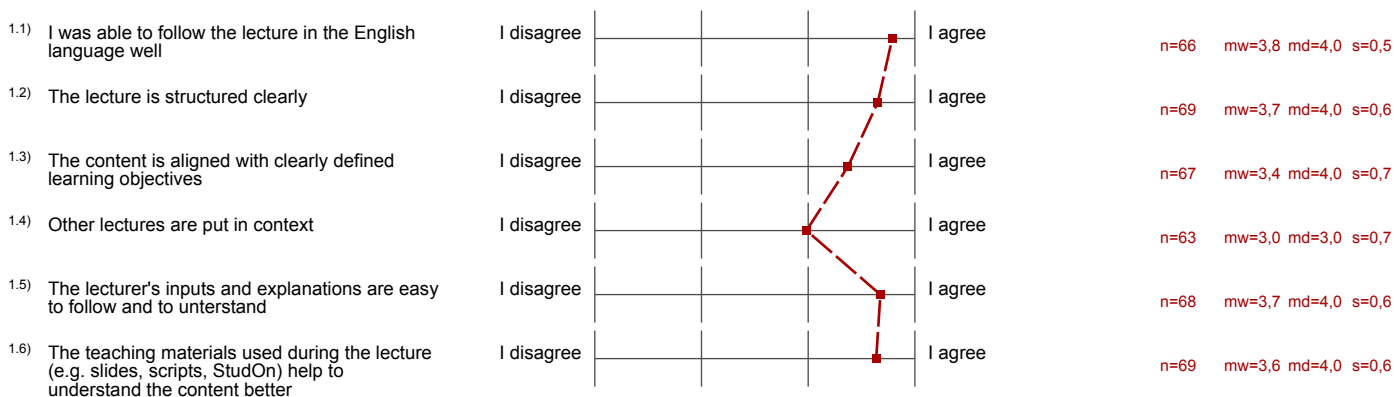
Have a look at the slides from Prof. Hungeberg. These are good, but too serious for this lecture.

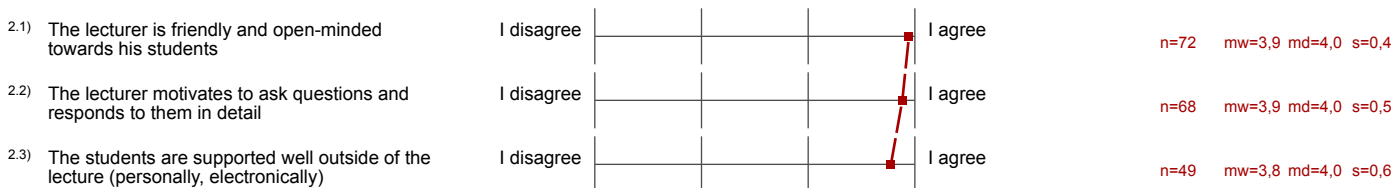

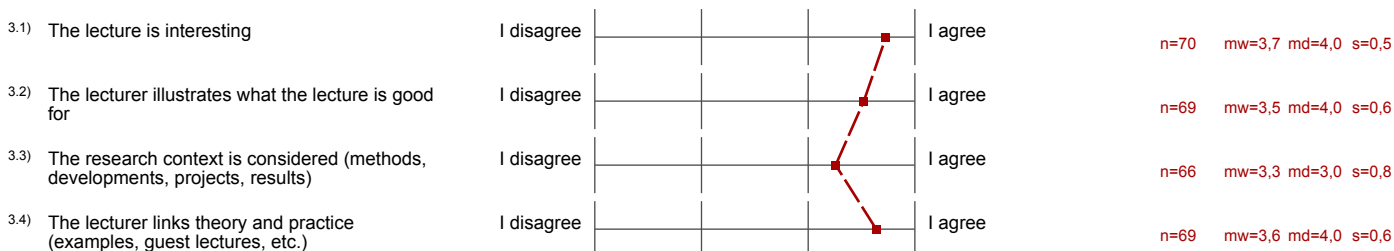

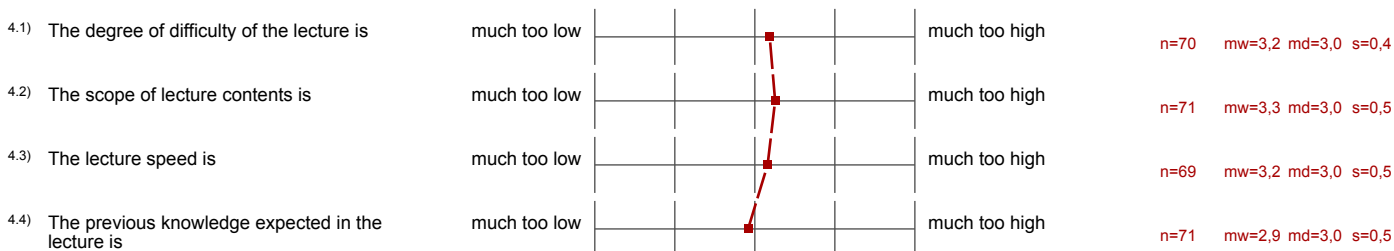
