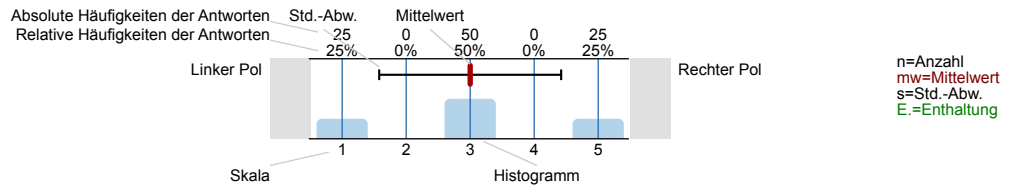




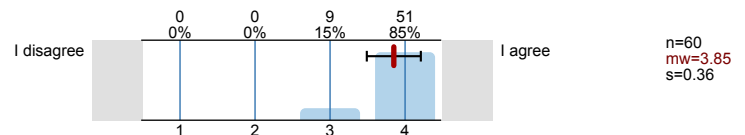

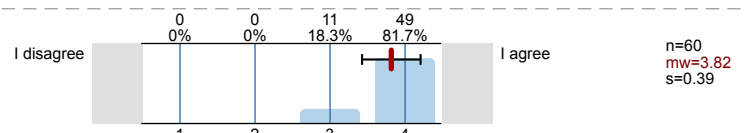
1.1) The students are supported well within the course



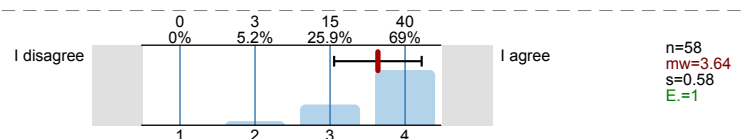
1.2) Good/bad support (see question 1.1), because...

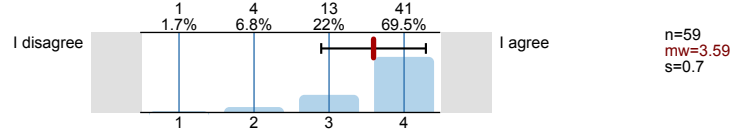

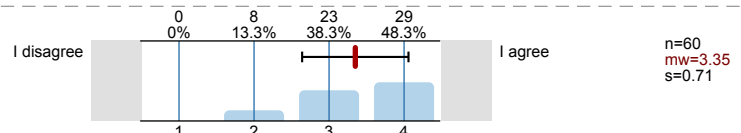

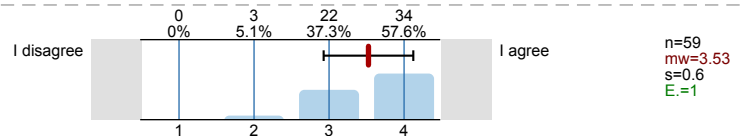

5.6) What are your suggestions for improvement? What could be implemented from other lectures?

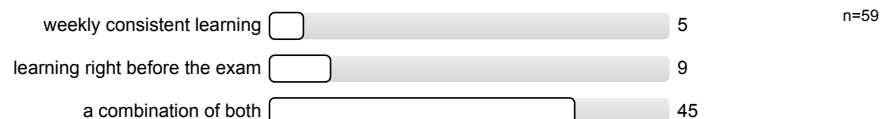
- A larger portion of the learning material could be self-taught, in order to free up more time for discussion
