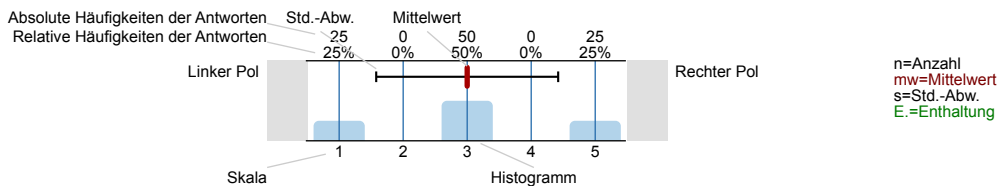




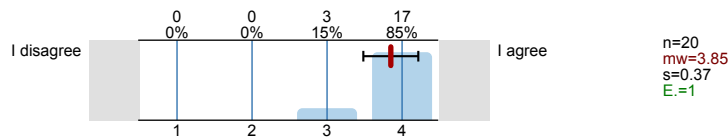

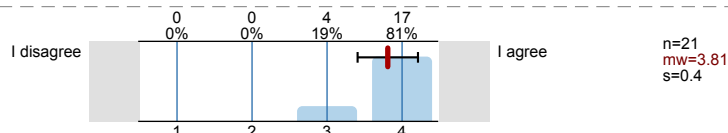
1.1) The students are supported well within the course



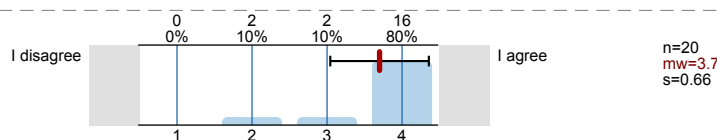
1.2) Good/bad support (see question 1.1), because...

5.5) What do you particularly like about the course?

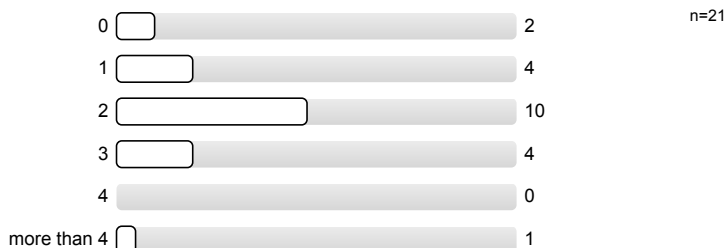
- Interesting topic

5.6) What are your suggestions for improvement? What could be implemented from other lectures?

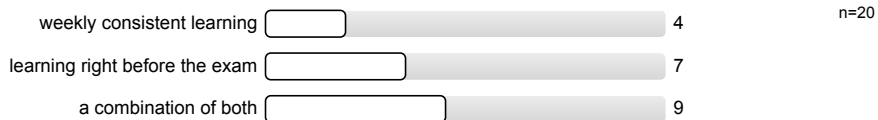
- I think it would be more interesting to have more discussion sessions, where everybody can state their opinion. Maybe even a debate from time to time.
