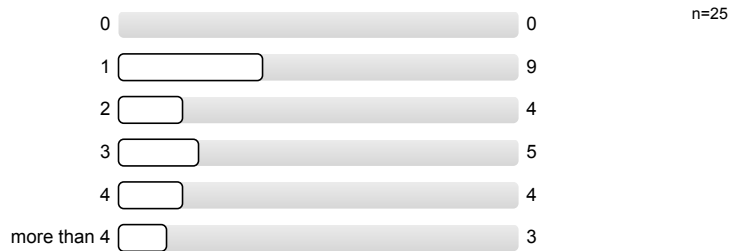
I really miss the Tutorium like it was offered last Semester in the business ethics course. That helped me a lot for the Exam preparation. Could you bring it back maybe?
