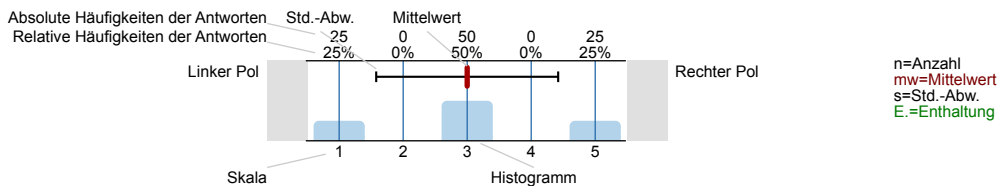




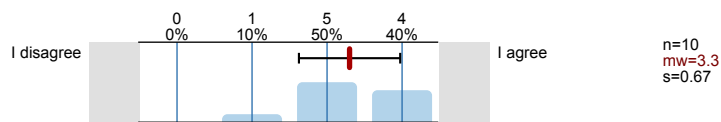

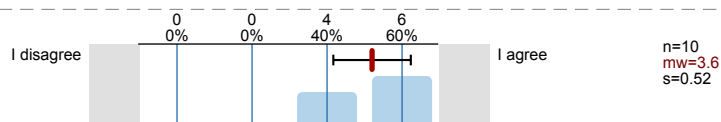
1.1) The students are supported well within the course



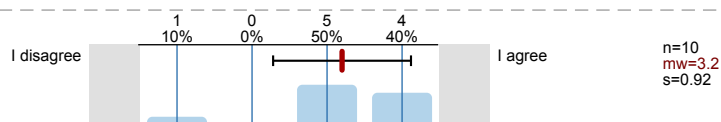
1.2) Good/bad support (see question 1.1), because...

1.3) The lecturer is able to transfer the knowledge very well

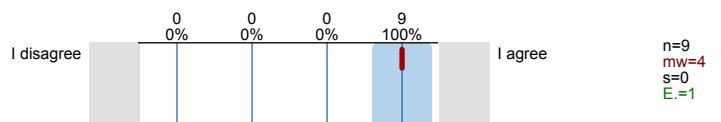

5.5) What do you particularly like about the course?

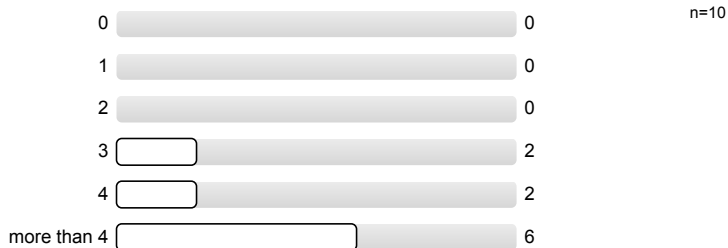
- I really liked the case studies, they were really interesting, I learned a lot

5.6) What are your suggestions for improvement? What could be implemented from other lectures?

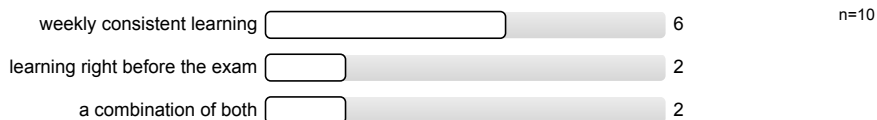
- 1. Drop the partner work concept. Either make it an individual seminar from the beginning or offer doing the assignments with a partner if the students feel like they need support/ a partner.

- A little less work would be great. Crossing out the end assignment is great and necessary because otherwise it would just be too much. But a little less work per week would be even better. For people who have less than 4 courses the amount is fine but with 5 other courses or the bachelor thesis next to 3 courses it sometimes can be a lot. But otherwise it's a great course and I really love it.
