- Maybe speaking more slowly

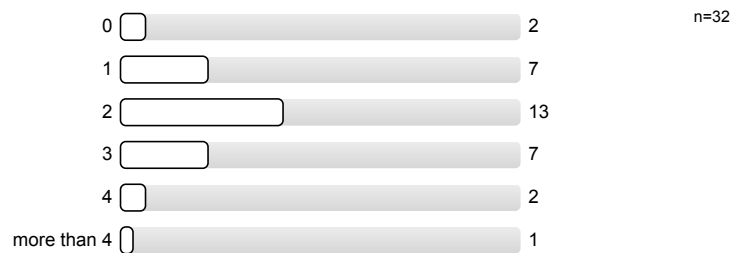
