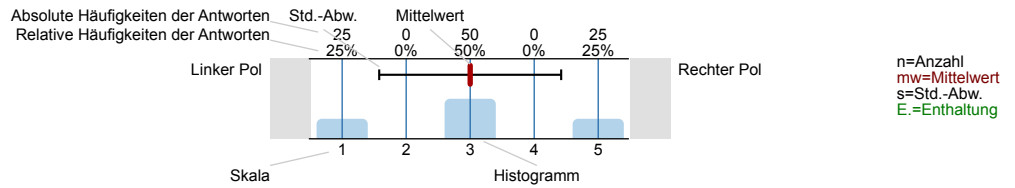




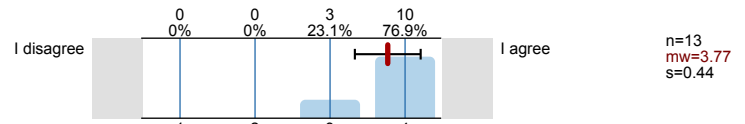

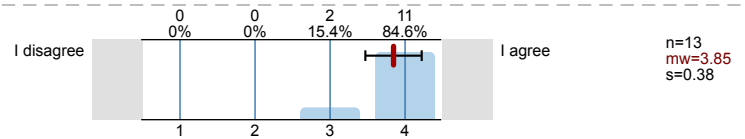
1.1) The students are supported well within the course



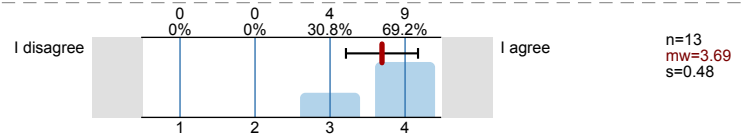
1.2) Good/bad support (see question 1.1), because...

- Supervisors are very helpful during the process of finding a research question, figuring out the overall structure of the thesis etc.

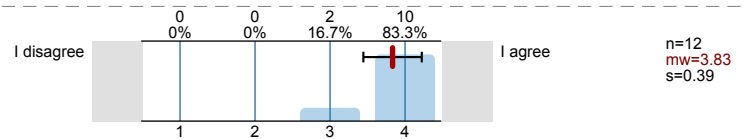

5.6) What are your suggestions for improvement? What could be implemented from other lectures?

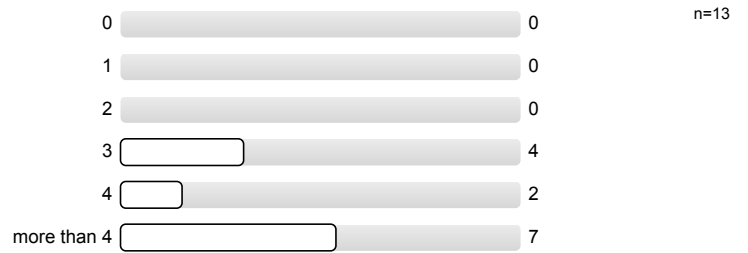
- A little more time between the Research question presentation/feedback and the exposé would have helped to make the exposé more well-rounded.
- Finding an alternative for a Miro board. The website is not very user-friendly. The page is huge and some information can be missed out
- For me personally, as I focus on a conceptual work, I didn't feel as supported as the "empirical group". There were lots of slides and information regarding empirical work but not as much for the conceptual work. I wish I had a bit more input here, even if it's just some additional sources or slides that I can read through by myself.
- I like that there are homeworks to hand in because they help to get me going, however, they did not always match with my thesis progress and I sometimes felt like they take up too much of the time I have to work on my thesis. This is probably also because my working student job has recently taken up more time than I expected, but it stressed me to be working on the homeworks instead of the thesis with the limited time I have and made me feel like I'm falling much behind or couldn't deliver the homeworks in the quality I would have wished for. However, I also see that there is only limited flexibility in the timing of the homeworks because of the semester schedule, so I don't really have a solution for that issue and just wanted to bring it up as a comment.
- Interactivity between students can be nice and assist in the research assignment, however in this aspect it should be separated between Master and Bachelor Students to improve the feedback results
- I would have liked to see some bachelor theses from the previous years in order to better understand what is required. But it is probably not possible.
- Maybe less hand ins and more focus on getting the research question established asap
- More time in between objectives/
Slow down the pace
- options to take more time for specific tasks or the overall process
- The course is on a very tight schedule which makes it difficult to solve uncertainties for the thesis project in time for the next deadline. Therefore, deadlines for important steps could be further apart.
